This event is the first large-scale event for Vietnamese workers in Japan and is a joint event for Vietnamese workers such as technical intern trainees, specified technical intern trainees, and engineers, as well as Japanese labor unions and accepting companies. The event was attended by approximately 500 people. It has been over 6 years since SOMETHING started accepting Vietnamese technical interns, and so far, we have accepted about 100 interns. In addition, as announced in the press release dated December 3, 2024, we are working to strengthen human resource development and employment support for foreign workers through the Future Create Cooperative, a business cooperative and supervisory organization that conducts joint acceptance projects for foreign technical interns and specified technical interns. Under these circumstances, our company received an award in recognition of its contribution to accepting Vietnamese workers and helping them learn technology and skills.

According to Ambassador Pham Quang Hieu, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Embassy of Vietnam in Japan, who gave the opening speech at the event, approximately 430,000 Vietnamese workers are said to be living and working in Japan with various residence statuses such as technical intern training, specified skills, and engineer status. He also stated that the workers who received experience and training in Japan will become valuable
